1. Guests

a. Mayor Gainey's Office- The office is committed to attending in person every other month, but will be available and following developments in the neighborhood. The Love Your Block Grant applications are open; award amount is \$5000. The Budget Team is interested in making their process more transparent. Residents are encouraged to complete the survey to share your input. The Office is seeking the public's help in recruiting lifeguards in the hopes of being fully staffed, allowing all pools to open.

b. Councilman Wilson's Office- Councilman Wilson can advocate for certain projects, so residents are encouraged to participate in capital budget forums to raise awareness of projects. The Plaque at Michael Flynn Field will be replaced ASAP. Councilman Wilson has introduced legislation to regulate short term rentals, voting has been held for public comment, contact the office to have your comments heard. Rental registration is rolling out this month, requiring every rental unit to register.

c. Zone 1 Representative- A photo has been released of one of a person of interest in the Easter Morning Airbnb shooting. Arrests have been made that police believe is related to the incident, ballistic reports are pending. No Part 1 crimes in the past 30 days.

d. State Rep Kinkead's Office- The Rep is kicking off a women's empowerment series tomorrow. Residents can reach out to the office for an appointment for help accessing state services.

e. Pittsburgh Parks Conservancy- Five dumpster loads of much were removed form Lake Elizabeth. More volunteer initiatives are coming up, see the website for a complete list.
